3 And wherever a new County shall be proposed to be formed
4 out of portions --

5 MR. GENTRY: What Article?

6 MR. CASE: Article 13. -- out of portions
7 of two or more Counties, the concept of a majority of the
8 legal voters of such part of each of said Counties respec-
9 tively shall be required.

10 Now, that may not be worded quite with the
11 artistic desire that some of the Members of this Commis-
12 sion seem to desire, and I would certainly be willing to
13 go along with any of the word surgeons who care to doctor
14 this one up a little bit, but the idea is that you have
15 to have a majority in both the acquiring and acquired
16 area before you can have the combination.
