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difficulties would be compounded because the Inner City would have no positive voting on this segmentation.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

Mrs. Freedlander?

MRS. FREEDLANDER: In the light of the discussion, although I am a Member of the Committee on Political Subdivisions, rather than have it be stricter, I would be inclined to not use the second paragraph of (b), but to end 11.01 at the first paragraph of (b), which is on Page 1 of our Report, and which gives to the General Assembly, which would be consistent with our desire to strengthen the General Assembly and give the State the power. The General Assembly may provide for, and end our recommendation with the first paragraph of (b).

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? I would like to state my views before we take a vote, because I think this is, if not the most important, certainly one of the most important provisions that this Commission will have to concern itself with.
