5 MRS. FREEDLANDER: In the light of the dis-
6 cussion, although I am a Member of the Committee on
7 Political Subdivisions, rather than have it be stricter,
8 I would be inclined to not use the second paragraph of
9 (b), but to end 11.01 at the first paragraph of (b),
10 which is on Page 1 of our Report, and which gives to the
11 General Assembly, which would be consistent with our
12 desire to strengthen the General Assembly and give the
13 State the power. The General Assembly may provide for,
14 and end our recommendation with the first paragraph of
15 (b).
