Why, for instance, do you care about the question whether the Legislature cares where the County seat is?

THE CHAIRMAN: Give us the substance of your substitute motion.

MR. SAYRE: I will be happy to strike that out.

MR. SAYRE: The General Assembly may provide by law for organizing new Counties and changing County lines. The General Assembly may submit to State wide referendum the proposed change. The referendum may also be submitted as provided by Article, whatever the Article is we have embodied in our draft.
