

1 MR. BOND: I will second.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan, do you want to
3 speak to the motion?

4 MR. SCANLAN: Me?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: This is a motion to substitute
6 for the pending motion a proposal made by Mr. Sayre.

7 MR. GLAGETT: You said Mr. Scanlan; did you
8 mean me?

9 THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry; yes, Mr. Glagett.

10 MR. SAYRE: I would like to say that the
11 simpler we have the manner in which the General Assembly
12 can change the internal structure of the State, I think
13 the better it would be for the welfare of all of the
14 State, and if we allow the judgment of the Legislature
15 to determine whether or not it wishes to submit the
16 question to referendum, that would be the judgment of
17 the Legislature. It does not prevent under our other
18 Article the people petitioning through State wide refer-
19 endum.

20 We should not make this subject to the locality
21 involved, and those are the principles involved in this
