Now if you are going to decide that, then perhaps I would also ask you to decide whether or not the whole provision about the budget shouldn't go the same way, because that would relieve my committee of about 80 per cent of its work. We could decide that real fast.

THE CHAIRMAN: Might I suggest, Judge
Adkins, that in the light of the discussion, that
perhaps it would be desirable to split the recommendation into two parts. First, that the Comptroller should
be an appointed rather than an elected official
and secondly the question of whether it should be a
Constitutional office or not, because there may be some
who are prepared to vote one way or the other on the one
