but I do think that the built-in flexibility and inflexibility of the proposal here does not make it impossible but would make it more possible.

THE CHAIRMAN: Anything further? The question arises on the motion to substitute for the pending motion the direction to the Committee to rewrite the second paragraph of Paragraph (b) of Section 11.01 so as to in substance authorize or provide that the General Assembly may provide by law to authorize new Counties and changing the County lines and may submit such act to a State wide referendum. The pending motion is to rewrite the paragraph to provide, in effect, that any change in County lines, transfer of an area from one County to another, cannot be accomplished except with the consent of the majority of the votes in the area to be transferred and in the area to which it is to be transferred. This does not embrace it, as I understand it, the consent of the area from which it is being transferred. Are you ready for the question?
