3 Ready for the question? All those in favor of  
4 substituting the motion for the pending motion will  
5 signify by a show of hands. Contrary? The motion is  
6 lost, 6 to 16. The question now arises on the motion by  
7 Mr. Case to rewrite the second paragraph of Paragraph (b)  
8 so as to provide in substance that County lines may be  
9 changed by the Legislature only subject to the approval  
10 of the majority of the voters in the area being trans-  
11 ferred to another County and in the County to which such  
12 area is being transferred.

13 MR. SYKES: Point of order. If this motion,  
14 should it pass, would it or would it not be in order  
15 afterwards, would a motion be in order to delete the  
16 entire second paragraph of Subsection (b)?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I would think it would be  
18 inconsistent with the purpose of it. If you wanted to  
19 delete the paragraph, I would suggest that the procedure  
20 would be to vote against the pending motion and then a  
21 motion to delete the paragraph, which would then be
