This is not a vote on his motion but merely on the question of whether to substitute.

Ready for the question? All those in favor of substituting the motion for the pending motion will signify by a show of hands. Contrary? The motion is lost, 6 to 16. The question now arises on the motion by Mr. Case to rewrite the second paragraph of Paragraph (b) so as to provide in substance that County lines may be changed by the Legislature only subject to the approval of the majority of the voters in the area being transferred to another County and in the County to which such area is being transferred.

MR. SYKES: Point of order. If this motion, should it pass, would it or would it not be in order afterwards, would a motion be in order to delete the entire second paragraph of Subsection (b)?

THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I would think it would be inconsistent with the purpose of it. If you wanted to delete the paragraph, I would suggest that the procedure would be to vote against the pending motion and then a motion to delete the paragraph, which would then be
