2 basic problem which is the main reason why we are grappling  
3 with a new Constitution today. If Justice Holmes was  
4 right in saying that the Constitution of the United  
5 States doesn't enact Herbert Spencer's social status, it  
6 seems to me that it is indisputable that we make a big  
7 mistake if we deliberately enact into the Constitution  
8 the very kind of parochialism which is strangling our  
9 government today, and if you take the biggest problem  
10 that we have and say, We won't give you the tools to  
11 solve it, and we will insure that you can't solve it,  
12 then we have been tinkering pretty uselessly and spend-  
13 ing an awful lot of time over refinements in other  
14 matters that would be rendered completely superfluous  
15 and meaningless.
