

1 to me that we can't still have the tools through inter-
2 regional governments and intergovernmental authorities,
3 and still continue the safeguards that the present Con-
4 stitution gives to the people.

5 MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, I want it to be
6 clear that if the motion fails, consideration of the
7 thought of Mr. Sykes that the whole paragraph can be
8 deleted will still equally remain open for consideration.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Essentially the paragraph will
10 still be before the Commission, either in its present
11 or amended form.

12 MR. DELLA: I think there is another way to
13 reach the solution to the problem which we are trying
14 to solve. I am not sure of the mechanics, but I know
15 New Jersey, for instance, has one County adjoining the
16 other with boroughs and everything else interlocking.
17 You have people living on one side of the street who
18 live in one County, and the others live in another.
19 The water, transportation, and everything else is handled
20 by one authority. I don't see why something can't be
21 worked out here.
