

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

2 Dr. Burdette?

3 DR. BURDETTE: Would you care to say where
4 Mr. Case's language goes in and what the words are?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: He has not proposed any precise
6 language, but a principle. The principal embodied in
7 this paragraph is that where the lines of a County are
8 changed and an area is transferred from one County to
9 another, that that can be accomplished only with the
10 consent of a majority of the voters residing in the area
11 to be transferred. He proposes that in addition, you
12 require the consent of the majority of the voters of the
13 County to which the area is to be transferred. It is an
14 added provision.

15 JUDGE ADKINS: I call the question, Mr. Chair-
16 man.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case?

18 MR. CASE: Mr. Chairman and Members of the Com-
19 mission, my purpose for offering this motion has been
20 served in one sense because I wanted, I thought we should
21 have a full discussion of the very important principle,
