2 will be before the Commission.

3 MR. CASE: That is not my motion.

4 MR. HOFF: It went beyond that. For the
5 whole County.

6 MR. CASE: Where a new County is formed by
7 the combination of two existing Counties, then it requires
8 the vote of a majority of the people in the County taking
9 over, and the County swallowing up.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: That is covered by the first
11 sentence.

12 MR. CASE: No, it isn't.

13 MR. CLAGETT: The difference is, it would
14 be the composite --

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Wait a minute. Let me under-
16 stand the motion. I have been stating it for the past
17 half hour. You are talking about a change in the lines
18 of a County, whether or not it results in the creation
19 of a whole new County.
