1 MR. SAYRE: You are not talking about that, 2 are you? THE CHAIRMAN: If we get a third party in 3 4 this discussion, I will never get it straight. MR. CLAGETT: Think of the problems I have. 5 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case, is your motion directed 7 at all to the change in the lines of a County, that is 8 transferring a part of one County to another County? 9 MR. CASE: No. 10 MR. CLAGETT: He is not talking about that. 11 MR. CASE: That is already provided for in 12 here. 13 THE CHAIRMAN: It is not provided in here. 14 It provides only for the vote of the people in the area 15 being transferred. 16 MR. CASE: That is right, and I buy this. THE CHAIRMAN: Let me suggest that we adjourn 17 18 for dinner. 19 MR. CASE: I will straighten it out. 20 (Whereupon the meeting adjourned, to reconvene 21 at 7:30 p.m. of the same day.)
