General Assembly here may provide rather than, shall provide by law for the creation of Counties and other civil divisions.

Now, omitted here is any reference to cities, but we move on further and define civil divisions as including regional governments and intergovernmental authority. Now, this is a consolidation of several Sections, and the recommendation of the Commission at the first presentation back on September 20, so that by this Section the General Assembly is creating Counties and civil divisions which will include regional governments and intergovernmental authorities but excluding municipal corporations; and I think in terms of municipal corporations as defined up in Subsection (a), meaning incorporated cities, towns or villages.

The General Assembly shall also provide for methods and procedures of creating, incorporating changing, merging and dissolving Counties and other civil divisions and altering their boundaries. Then we go ahead and with respect to the altering of boundaries, take care of the situation where a new County is created
