4 MR. SCANLAN: Did you mean the second paragraph
5 (b) to be the second paragraph or a Subsection of (c),
6 beginning on the top of Page 2? As it stands now, it is
7 the second paragraph of your --

8 MR. CLAGETT: The second Subsection of Para-
9 graph (b). I don't mean it to be a Subsection of Para-
10 graph (c) because there we are dealing with the last
11 phrase of Subsection (b) as it appears on Page 1, alter-
12 ing of boundaries; and then we try to compromise a
13 degree of flexibility insofar as changing is concerned
14 with a degree of inflexibility to maintain rather than
15 have promiscuous change.
