

1 You mean any general public applicable to Counties in
2 its class.

3 JUDGE ADKINS: The County might be exempt if
4 the law is not applicable to classes.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: No, what you mean, if you
6 divided the State into five classes, you might have a
7 public general law applicable to two classes but not the
8 other three.

9 JUDGE ADKINS: Is there any reason under this
10 provision why a County might not elect to exempt itself?

11 THE CHAIRMAN: It is intended. Whether the
12 language is clear, I don't know.

13 JUDGE ADKINS: My question is whether the
14 language is clear.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Well again, let's come back
16 to it.

17 Mr. Sykes?

18 MR. SYKES: What is the purpose of the word
19 in its effect? I am thinking particularly of Mr. Della's
20 example where you might have a law applicable to strip
21 mining passed as a general State wide law, but it only
