3 MR. SCANLAN: Doesn't the phrase, without  
4 exception, get it?

5 MR. CLAGETT: Not quite.

6 MR. SCANLAN: You want a phrase in there  
7 saying we really mean it.

8 MR. CLAGETT: Let it be known we really mean  
9 it. Subsection (d), the General Assembly may authorize  
10 civil divisions other than Counties and municipal  
11 corporations to administer single or multi-purpose func-  
12 tions that transcend local boundaries and grant to  
13 them the power to impose and collect revenues to borrow  
14 money and to collect taxes imposed by the General Assem-  
15 bly.

16 Now, here we are speaking out that the General  
17 Assembly may take advantage of the device of inter-  
18 governmental authorities within the authorization to  
19 create civil divisions, and we are spelling it out for  
20 purposes of clarification and for purposes also of carry-  
21 ing out the Commission's restriction to be imposed upon
