MR. CASE: I would suggest to the Chairman that our recommendation is not so restrictive and that indeed, it could be possible and should be allowed that these civil divisions could collect taxes imposed by the, by other elected bodies than the General Assembly. For example, one of the best illustrations of your civil divisions is your Sanitary Division, which can be created under the new provisions of Article 43 in any of the Counties. These districts are permitted to determine whether or not a tax is necessary, and if a tax is necessary, then the County Commissioners are given the right to impose that tax. It goes on the tax bill and is used for their purposes.

So I am suggesting that the use of the words, General Assembly, in this context should be broadened to
