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talking about, and actually, the way you have it written here, in accordance with our current practice, would be really inapplicable because the taxes that these local civil divisions actually collect are not imposed by the General Assembly at all. They are imposed by the County Commissioners. So the way you've got it written, the way the Committee has it written just wouldn't work. You are talking about direct taxes, real estate taxes, by and large.

> MR. CLAGETT: That is correct.

MR. CASE: And these are not imposed by the General Assembly.

MR. CLAGETT: All right, I would suggest that when we get back to that, we might enlarge it because what we do intend to imply here is that the correct taxes shall be imposed by a representative legislative group rather than necessarily restricting it to the General Assembly.

MR. CASE: But may be collected by the civil

division.
