

1 MR. CLAGETT: As in the case -- well, no, the  
2 Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission determines the  
3 rate, and the County does the actual collecting.

4 MR. CASE: That is the point. The County  
5 does the actual imposing, and in that case, the collect-  
6 ing, but in some areas, the County does the imposing but  
7 the civil division does the collecting.

8 MR. CLAGETT: True.

9 MR. DELLA: Are Hal and Dick talking about  
10 income taxes as well as revenue taxes, or just revenue  
11 taxes?

12 MR. CLAGETT: We were there talking about  
13 direct taxes on property.

14 MR. DELLA: And not income taxes?

15 MR. CLAGETT: Not at that point.

16 DR. MICHENER: I would like to ask the converse  
17 of the question. Can the General Assembly under its  
18 prohibition against local legislation render a tax against  
19 the district they are going to collect?

20 MR. CLAGETT: If it does so generally in terms  
21 applicable to all Counties.
