the grant of Home Rule power. Secondly, on request of the executive and legislative authority of any County or on a petition bearing the signatures of 10 per cent of the qualified voters provided that in any case 10,000 signatures shall be sufficient to complete a petition, the officer or agency responsible for certifying public questions shall provide at the next general election for the election of a charter board of five registered voters from that Nominations for members of the charter board may be made not less than 40 days prior to the election by the executive and legislative authority of the County or not less than 20 days prior to the election by a petition bearing the signatures of 5 per cent of the qualified voters provided that in any case 2000 signatures shall be sufficient to complete a nominating petition. At the election, the ballot shall contain names of the nominees and shall be so arranged as to permit voters to vote for or against the creation of a charter board. If the majority of the votes cast on a proposal to create

a charter board is against the proposal, the election
