They are two different things.

DR. BURDETTE: You brought this up.

MR. CLAGETT: This is the referendum protection in the County, and it would be a majority of the voters voting on the question?

DR. MICHENER: That is not what I said.

MR. CLAGETT: Let me suggest this: Because we ended up at 12:30 Thursday night, and we rewrote this Section, and I didn't have the benefit of getting the new Section until today, I rewrote the Section on the tasks of our understanding, and I prefer what I wrote then to what I am reading now. It is basically the same thing, but it simplifies it and clarifies it. We do propose as a Committee to take this very language we are reading now and simplify it and clarify it. It will be the voters voting on the question, the majority of the voters voting on the question.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan?

MR. SCANLAN: The only comment I have is that this Section seems unduly long, and you have now and especially Paragraph 2 and 3, a matter that I think would
