2 am not suggesting at this late hour that I could suggest  
3 language that would incorporate in another sentence tacked  
4 onto A-1, all you have specified in 2 and 3, but I do  
5 think --

7 a draft. It is in your hands, and we can come to it  
8 when we consider the language later. Let me say in further  
9 response to Mr. Sykes that I personally think one of the  
10 difficulties with the earlier Section is that there is  
11 nothing that says in so many words that the existing  
12 Counties shall be, shall continue until changed by the  
13 Legislature, but I think if you had such a provision,  
14 that tied in with 11.03 or rephrasing it would carry out  
15 the intent of the Committee, that a County may have  
16 almost any form of government, either the County Com-  
17 missioner form of government or charter form of govern-  
18 ment or some other form of government, but whatever form  
19 of government it has, it must exercise the power of local  
20 legislation.
