2 that is an alternative and is not the recommendation of
3 the Committee.

4 MR. CASE: Isn't the practical answer to what
5 Mr. Sykes is saying, and I certainly share is apprehension
6 that the words that are used here, that Legislature
7 will not be authorized or empowered to pass any local
8 legislation after this goes into effect. If you can't pass
9 any local legislation, the County has to go to one of
10 these things pretty fast or if it doesn't, it can't
11 do anything.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: It could pass local legislation
13 by the County Commissioner form of government.

14 MR. CASE: Well then, it is given charter in
15 effect, charter type of government, Code type of govern-
16 ment which brings me to a second question, if I may ask
17 the Chairman; and that is, would you state for us as
18 succinctly as you may or wish to, just what the differ-
19 ence is between the substance of this draft that you have
20 now read and the substance of what we will have after the
21 people adopt the constitutional amendment? That is on
