working on details of the Enabling Act, the

Committee changed its mind on this and in the interest
of simplicity would just eliminate the mileage
allowance. It isn't that significant. We thought in
the interest again of simplicity the \$50 a day for
everybody was the most equitable and the most simple
mode of compensation.

So apart from that one last phrase on Page 9, our recommendation would be that the delegates to the convention be paid \$50 a day when they are attending sessions of the convention or on the business of the convention such as attending Committee meetings, subcommittee meetings, and that sort. That would be your Committee's recommendation.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions? Mr. Case.

MR. CASE: Mr. Chairman, I take it that

the Committee is aware of the fact that a set sum per day when attending sessions or meetings of committees has run into some pretty rough sailing around the state. I assume what you mean is a flat \$50 a day,

period, no matter how many committee meetings you attend.
