respect to existing municipalities many of the things and perhaps all of the things covered in the first sentence with respect to new municipalities.

MR. CLAGETT: That is correct.

MR. CASE: We will not be asked to vote up or down in this form, will we?

THE CHAIRMAN: No.

MR. CLAGETT: We will introduce the alternative as possible substitute language.

THE CHAIRMAN: Let me add a comment to Senator
Hoff's question. The Committee has pointed out, Senator

Hoff, that by statute in Maryland no new municipality can now be created without the consent of the County in which it is located. Any further question about 11.04?

MR. CASE: I would say one thing, and it has been my experience that the right of annexation or the privilege of annexation is a very, very important thing to existing municipalities in this State, and I can cite to you two very, very rapidly growing municipalities which are very progressive and are bringing a lot to their respective Counties, and they are Rockville and
