Now one of the answers to your problem is the fact that it would require the concurrence of the Chief Executive under the veto power to accomplish what you are talking about.

DR. JENKINS: Judge Adkins points out we are getting into a much broader field than the report covers, but the statement here that the Governor should appoint all department heads, is it the thinking of the Committee that this extends, let us say, to the department of the president of the University of Maryland?

JUDGE ADKINS: No.

DR. JENKINS: There will be some areas excluded. JUDGE ADKINS: That would come under the Education Committee, the report of which is before
