4 that these other drafts will be ignored by us.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: I am going to make this sug-
6 gestion to you if it meets with the approval of all of
7 you, in the 20 minutes that we have left for this Section.
8 I would like to give Mrs. Kostritsky an opportunity to
9 address the Commission with respect to part of the prob-
10 lems in this area. As all of you know, she is not only
11 a reporter for this Commission and has been working very
12 closely with this particular Committee, but in addition
13 to that, she has been employed full time for more than
14 a year by the City of Baltimore as part of a task force
15 specifically working on the Constitution. I would also
16 like to give Mr. Brooks a few minutes to outline in gen-
17 eral form the Staff memo and to give Mr. Sayre a few
18 minutes to outline his views. I think if you have those
19 three and they will all have to be limited, because if
20 we cut them up into 20 minutes, it will mean six or seven
21 minutes apiece, you will get a pretty comprehensive pic-
