appreciations expand just as the sun comes up and goes into the highest point and then settles. Last night when it settled some new ideas dawned contrary to the normal working of the pattern and I think we have got a suggested solution to one aspect of our problem this morning which will greatly simplify the decision making responsibility which the Commission has. Let me direct your attention now to the Sixth Report and

Page 10 of that report.

Section 11.01 sets forth the units of local government and subsection (a) defines those units as consisting of 24 counties, the 23 existing counties and Baltimore City included as a county.

Then it takes the phrase municipal corporation and defines it to mean an incorporated city, town, or village but shall not include Baltimore City or any county because of just the reason I have said heretofore, counties and municipal corporations being the two units of government to be provided for in this Constitution.

Are there any questions about that? If not, then moving on into subsection (b), the General Assembly may
