nature of regional government, at the very least including the word representative. I am beginning to lean overnight. I don't change my opinions lightly but I am leaning to the opinion that we will simply make a tremendous mistake if we don't do something to encourage the Legislature, to point out to the Legislature how it can make representative government really function in this state.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any other questions as to this section? Now, this section, as has been indicated, poses both of the fundamental problems as to which there is this divergence of views and I suggest that you look at the other two memoranda because on the one issue of providing a dormant regional government they are the same although they differ in detail.

I am not suggesting that the language of any one of the three drafts is necessarily the language you want, but if you will look at the one marked staff memoranda, you will see that it starts by saying the units of government shall be regions, counties, and cities. The other one has the same notation except it
