says that the power of local government other than the judicial power and that is one of the matters I should have mentioned. I think all of us are in agreement that the judicial power should not be vested in local government. We don't want town or county courts. But this article says that the power of local government other than the judicial power is vested in -- and then there is a whole series of names you can give the regions, counties and municipal corporations, so that the difference fundamentally, there is the one says the power of local government is in regions, counties and municipalities, the other says the Legislature may create regions.
