is to propose to the Commission the alternative of placing in the Legislature the power to merge and change, create, and dissolve counties. I think it fits in with the desire to create a strong Legislature that is necessary to give the Legislature the tools to deal with this most important problem and that to build in a parochialism into the Constitution is a big mistake. I think this is one situation where you are going to have to trust the Legislature because if you don't and you attempt to provide for what must be a local veto, at least to some extent you are going to make it impossible for the state to deal with statewide problems.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe.

MRS. BOTHE: I wonder if Mr. Sykes would be interested in accepting an amendment requiring extraordinary vote of the Legislature.

MR. SYKES: That is a nice question. I am not prepared to accept it at this point but it is an interesting approach that I hadn't thought about.
