parties as I stated yesterday, the interested parties, 1 2 where a part of a county is concerned is the people in it, who are being left and I think it would be virtually impossible to get a three layer referendum and there could be no change at all. I am in favor of this plus 5 6 the suggestion of Mrs. Bothe of an extraordinary vote 7 of the Legislature. THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? 9 DR. JENKINS: Which could be handled by 10 later amendment. 11 THE CHATEMAN: Any further discussion? 12 13 on your motion?

You ready for the question? Mr. Sykes, you want to consider further an amendment or do you want to stand

MR. SYKES: I would like to put it this way with the understanding that it is subject to further amendment, even if the motion passes.

THE CHAIRMAN: Before we vote, I would like to state very briefly my own views. I think this is a very, very sensitive area and I think we are caught on the horns of dilemma of either giving the
