I tried drafting just what Mr. Sykes has suggested and abandoned it when I began to run into the very problems that we have now illustrated where you go from the provision for transcending county lines and then you go into regions and you start transcending the regional lines and so on you go, ad infinitum.

Perfectly frankly, I think we are beginning to get into focus the question of whether or not we want to provide for regional structural representative government or not and I think ultimately we are going to appreciate that the choice is going to be between an approach along that line or the approach along the line of the intergovernmental authorities, the provision for regional government when and if that day should come.

But in the meantime with a degree of elasticity insofar as classification is concerned and a degree of elasticity insofar as 11.02 subsection (d) providing for the General Assembly to utilize the civil division and whatever that form shall be as time and circumstance and problem shall define it; to take care of the problems that transcend local boundaries and to utilize the degree
