of resourcefulness, to continue to use the degree of resourcefulness insofar as moving toward something else as it may be defined in the future with a little purer appreciation than we can quite see it now.

MR. BROOKS: Unfortunately, there seems to be two different questions being debated at the moment. One is whether there should be regional or intergovernmental authorities and the other as to whether or not they should be limited in aspect. The problem of a proliferation of intergovernmental authorities has been referred to on at least three occasions as a problem of the future.

Unfortunately, it is a problem of the present. It is one that we receive numerous complaints about at the moment, the fact that present existing intergovernmental authorities are not cooperating with each other and the appointing agents or authorities of the people who are on the authorities have no control over the authorities which brings into focus another problem which is whether or not the authorities should be in any way representative.
