on the floor deals with primarily regional, excuse me, intergovernmental authorities using the term that they are not really a great number of political problems inherent under the motion that is proposed, in that as soon as one authority is created for a specific purpose, you then have the problem of reorganizing that authority whenever you want to assign to it a second purpose, in that most authorities are appointed, so to speak, specialists or people with particular interests to deal with the problem for which the authorities are created.

When it is assigned, the second function, you immediately have the problem of whether or not you want any people on that authority who have some special competence in the new task assigned to it. So you have to reorganize the authority. Then you have to repeat that when you assign it a third function.

Also under the motion as proposed, you also have the problem that the General Assembly may create that authority and thus may completely control the membership of the authority with all the functions
