very seriously, that you keep creating within one authority a hybrid. You get 10, 15, 16 different authorities into one. You merely give lip service to the Constitution but creating chaos in the end.

I think what we really want is regional intergovernment agencies and leave it there and let the Legislature go from there and put our trust in the Legislature. I think I would be against the motion as it is amended because it ties up the Legislature in the future forever.

MR. MITCHELL: Mr. Chairman, I think I see the need of a regional government and I think an example would be, if I may again cite my home county of Prince Georges and Montgomery. We have two bi-county agencies. I am sure everybody has heard of them, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and the Park and Planning Commission and these, I think these two agencies are valuable but there is nothing to require any coordination between these two agencies.

I think that in order to require that, and I think that is becoming more important, it would
