be necessary under the existing framework or that suggested by Mr. Hargrove to appoint a supercommission over the two of them. Now another thing as the population of those two counties increases, then their tolerance increases and there is no direct representation or we lose the right to vote for the membership of these two Commissions.

I think, I don't like that -- I would like to have a vote of the members of those Commissions.

I think that points out the need of a regional government based on experience and what I observe day by day and yet, I don't think that solves all the problems so for that reason I think that I am going to vote for Mr. Martineau's amendment.

MR. BROOKS: Excuse me. One point of clarification. I think several remarks would indicate that some are under the assumption that only the General Assembly can create intergovernmental authorities.

Of course, under this provision, there is no restriction against the present practice of not only the General Assembly but all the other governments in the state and
