THE CHAIRMAN: I think right about now is the appropriate time for any who want to, to move this question.

DR. BARD: That is why I feel that this kind of discussion which Mr. Sykes is carrying out could really have been a little more clearer had we made that determination first and this is my difficulty in even understanding the motives or the purposes.

MR. CLAGETT: I believe you ought to go a little bit further with the report and then dissolve that question because, I think, in fully appreciating the recommendation of the Committee as against the alternative, you have got to have appreciation of other provisions.

DR. BARD: Okay.

MR. GLAGETT: Particularly the power being granted to the power, the classification being allowable insofar as the General Assembly is concerned --

THE CHAIRAN: Since we have already been over those and we can have the bird's eye view, don't you think we could consider the question then?
