as to why the draft I had prepared does not expressly provide for representative government. I would subscribe wholeheartedly to the view expressed by Dr. Burdette if we were consideration a regional government only as a full government. I think anything less than a fully directly elected representative government in that situation would not be desirable.

This is an area where I fear too much rigidity in the Constitution and if we think of a possible regional government as one exercising only one or two functions as for instance the transit function or the sewer function, it seems to me that it might be considered desirable for that to be managed by a group selected by the governing bodies of the component parts; for instance, again if you have a metropolitan area of Baltimore dealing only with transit and sewers which are one of the really, or two of the really vital problems that you might have the governing board
