or body, whatever it might be called, consisting of representatives elected by the County Council of Baltimore County and the County Council of Anne Arundel County and the City Council of Baltimore and that would not be an elected representative body.

On the other hand, if that body is to have the power to tax, I think all of our traditions and the things ingrained in us make us say that it must be a direct representative government. But I think we have that in the provision, yes, sir.

I do not feel strongly about it. I simply point out this is again one of those areas where it is easy to say it ought to be representative government if you know exactly what you are talking about but when we don't know what the future holds, this may be a problem.

MR. MILLER: Might it not be difficult to get the right people to serve on some of these boards where they are only part time. If they had to run for an election, you would have a great deal of trouble in some areas whereas if the County Commissioners or county governing body would appoint them, they would still be
