in favor of that proposition. So a vote aye is a vote in favor of the constitutional requirement that regional governments shall be representative governments.

DR. JENKINS: Does this mean regional government with the power to tax?

THE CHAIRMAN: Would have the power to action or not have the power to action.

THE CHAIRMAN: The vote age is a vote in favor of the constitutional requirement for representative government in a regional government. A vote age is a vote in favor of representative government for a regional government. All those in favor, please signify by a shew of hands. Those opposed, raise your hands.

The motion is carried twelve to seven.
