restrict any individual member of the Committee in expressing his or her position contrary to that of the majority, but it is the thinking of the Committee that where you take the four corners of our proposal and you carefully appreciate it, what we have done here is we have attempted to vitalize the county government, the local government and the basic unit of the local government is the county and yet, at the moment, we have tried to give to the General Assembly a degree of flexibility so that it can take care of matters which are truly general public policy throughout the state.

Now, if you are going to activate the counties and you are going to give them the broad grant of power which we have given here and if you are going to give the General Assembly the power of classification which gives it a degree of flexibility to deal with regional matters, or matters which transcend county lines, thus giving them a degree of flexibility from merely passing general laws which must affect all counties in terms and affect and say that they can pass general laws which shall apply to all of the counties within a
