classification, which may be only three counties --I feel that we have given there, a degree of, we have given a tool to the General Assembly to deal with the pocket of urban development which has created such a problem by reason of the population explosion, particularly 5 insofar as that pocket may be around the Washington area, Montgomery, Prince Georges, and Howard and where 7 there may be a similar pocket around Baltimore in the 8 city, the Baltimore County and Howard. Now if we are 9 going to approach the problem by this method, namely the 10 broad grant of powers to the counties and the degree of 11 flexibility insofar as the General Assembly is concerned 12 but divorcing it from local matters and putting it 13 up on the level of general public policy, then to come 14 along and create in between those two governments, a 15 regional government, I think is doing what? It is doing 16 just the opposite of what the Committee has attempted 17 18 to do here.
