degree of confidence in that General Assembly to take care of this problem. There is nothing in the recommendation of the Committee which would prevent the General Assembly from creating a regional government which shall be representative in its composition or shall be something else in its composition.

We don't know -- when that day comes is one that is so far away we don't know whether it will ever be necessary because we don't know the full extent and use of the other media that are immediately available to us insofar as the intergovernmental relationships or authorities are concerned.

So it is that I view the trend that is evident so far insofar as our decision upon these policy questions as putting the Commission on record as favoring a structure of government which well may not be the proper structure at the time when the real need and not just the feared need would be there.

One other point. In sofar as intergovernmental authorities are concerned, there are only at this time will be total of 126 in the interestate and of that 126 only
