,

skeleton such as I would envision it were put into the Constitution and that the net effect of putting it in would be psychological and suggestive.

That is these regional governments would be dormant purely until the Legislature chose to activate them. I think that the localities should have a right to initiate their activation but only subject to the veto of the Legislature, the same way localities can contract for intergovernmental authorities. I think that if the Legislature is given the power over the activiation, then the Legislature retains all the power and what we are talking about is essentially a psychological question and the answer depends upon how strongly you value a push toward regional government, and I personally value it very highly.

THE CHAIRMAN: Let me make just two comments. First, so that there will be no misunderstanding, I think we ought to consider separately and as a separate question the question of how many regions or if there ought to be any limit on the number of regions because even if one favors regions, I can see that there might
