to occur and I think this matter of, I think for a state to draft into the Constitution a political game which you think is more likely to achieve the result you want, and secondly, I think it is a mistake to think the Legislature isn't going to do this if the region or the people in the region want it to be done.

I think if they want it to be, if the local governing tody, a substantial number of people in the community or in the region that want the regional government to be created, the Legislature is going to do it.

Lastly I think it would be a serious mistake to permit the creation of a regional government, that is an entirely new functioning governing body governing a substantial portion of the state without the consent of the Legislature.

I think this is uniquely a question that can be decided only by the Legislature and should be decided only by the Legislature. For that reason I would hope the motion would fail or pass, I am not sure which.
