first. Then the question turns, should the people of such a region be able to activite. I would favor that because I don't mean it should be exclusive, I think it should be activatable either by the Legislature or the people because I think every now and then people in public office and place get a certain vested interest and there comes times when I hope would be as infrequent as possible that the people must move to make a change.

Now this is exactly the same principle that we apply with respect to the charter government in the state.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Freedlander.

MRS. FREEDIANDER: We have had precedent in the existing Constitution providing for classification of cities. I am not speaking in favor of that and there has been no classification of cities so you could provide in the Constitution for including regional government and intergovermental authorities and never have it activated and we know in the Baltimore Metropolitan area that the county executives of Anne Arundel County and Baltimore County and the Republican Mayor of the
