proposal because of Section 11.05 what we have achieved if we were to adopt the proposed (b) section and only permit the General Assembly to create regional governments, we would be assuring ourselves the multiplicity of regional authorities because local government has constitutionally the power to establish the regional authorities. They would not have the power to create any kind of regional government.

Thus we have constitutionally provided for the alternative of the regional authorities and have practically assured that will be the direction in which the level of government between the counties and the state will go in.

Second, I want to raise a question. I understood the vote to be a permissive vote to give the General Assembly the power to create regional representative governments a while ago. Since then there has been some question of whether or not the General Assembly would in advance have to create any regions. The draft provides for the creation of regional governments.

I thought the vote was between whether it
